As part of one of the 50 selected global participants, you will build your expertise on the ground while developing Communication, Leadership, Innovation, Management and Entrepreneurial skills with international experts and a systems perspective on the impact sector.

You will also strategize your career path and become part of a thriving community of impact professionals.

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

The 6-month Social Innovation Management program (2-month Foundation online, and 4-month Immersion in person) includes:

- ► A 250-hour+ apprenticeship in a local organization (for those who are not already working) to immediately apply your learning on the job and make sense of the impact sector
- ► A wide range of networking opportunities to introduce you to the community of changemakers in the city of your immersion, with guest speakers, events, and social gatherings
- ▶ 2 intensive learning trips with your classmates
- ▶ Global dialogue video calls with Fellows from other countries and webinar with alumni to strengthen your connection to the community and learn from peers
- 6 individual support sessions during and after the program to support you in consolidating your career

- from February to July 2020 (April-July Immersion in Brazil or India)
- from July to December 2020 (September-December Immersion in Brazil or Kenya)


